

Elementary 5th & 6th Grade Volleyball Tournament
Glen Ullin High School
April 2nd, 2022

A tournament for grades 5 and 6 for elementary volleyball has been scheduled for April 2nd at **Glen Ullin High School**. The main purpose of the day is to allow this age group to get more playing experience. Each team is guaranteed three matches.

1. The 5th grade tournament will start at 9:00 a.m. central time. The 6th grade tournament will start at 12:45 p.m. central time.
2. Each match will consist of two 12-minute timed sets or the first team to 25. (It is not win by 2.).
3. If the teams are tied at the end of the 12 minutes, we will play one more point.
4. There will be a 2-minute break between each set.
5. There will be 4 minutes between matches. This can be used for warm-up for the next teams on the court.
6. We will do our best to stay on schedule, if this means less time between matches, so be it. If we get ahead of schedule, great!
7. There will only be one official per match, and it will be a high school student. Please show your patience with them, as it is a learning experience for them as well.
8. Each team will have to provide one (1) line judge per match.
9. Glen Ullin School will provide all game and practice balls. We will be using standard weight volleyballs for all grades. All will use standard height net.
10. Athletes must serve behind the 10-foot line.
11. 5th and 6th will each be in tournament format
 - a. 2 pools in each division
 - b. Each team is guaranteed 3 matches
 - c. Places in each pool will be determined by the following:
 - i. 3 points per team for winning both sets in a match
 - ii. 2 points per team for winning one set with the most combined points
 - iii. 1 point per team for winning one set with the least points combined
 - iv. 0 points per team for not winning a set
 - d. If there is a tie after pool play:
 - i. Head to Head
 - ii. Largest point differential between tied teams (Cap at 10/match)
 - iii. Coin flip
 - e. After pool play, we will have the tournament matches. 5th and 6th grade will be seeded as shown below.
 - i. Pool points
 - ii. Largest point differential (Cap at 10/match)
 - iii. Coin flip

Concessions will be available throughout each day! **Please note that times are Central Time.** If you have any questions, feel free to call me. There is an entry fee of \$20/team. Make check payable to **Glen Ullin Public School.** Admission of \$3 for adults and \$2 for students will be charged. Thank you!

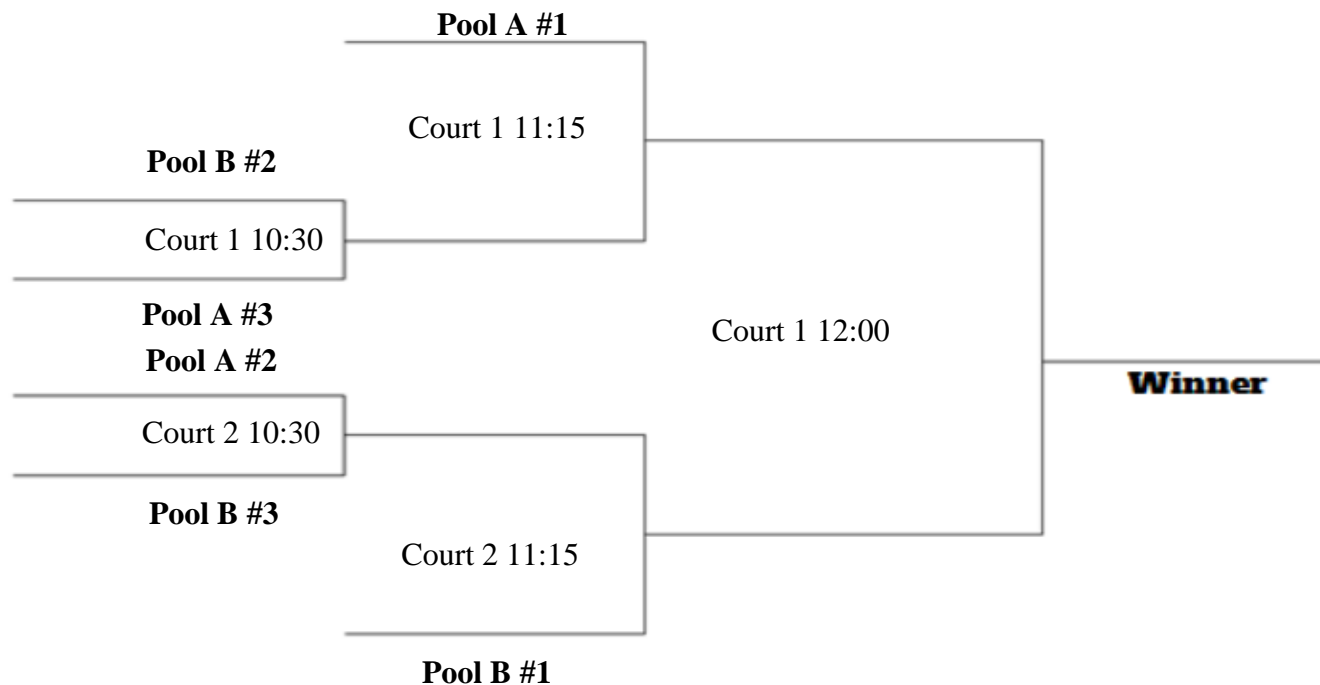

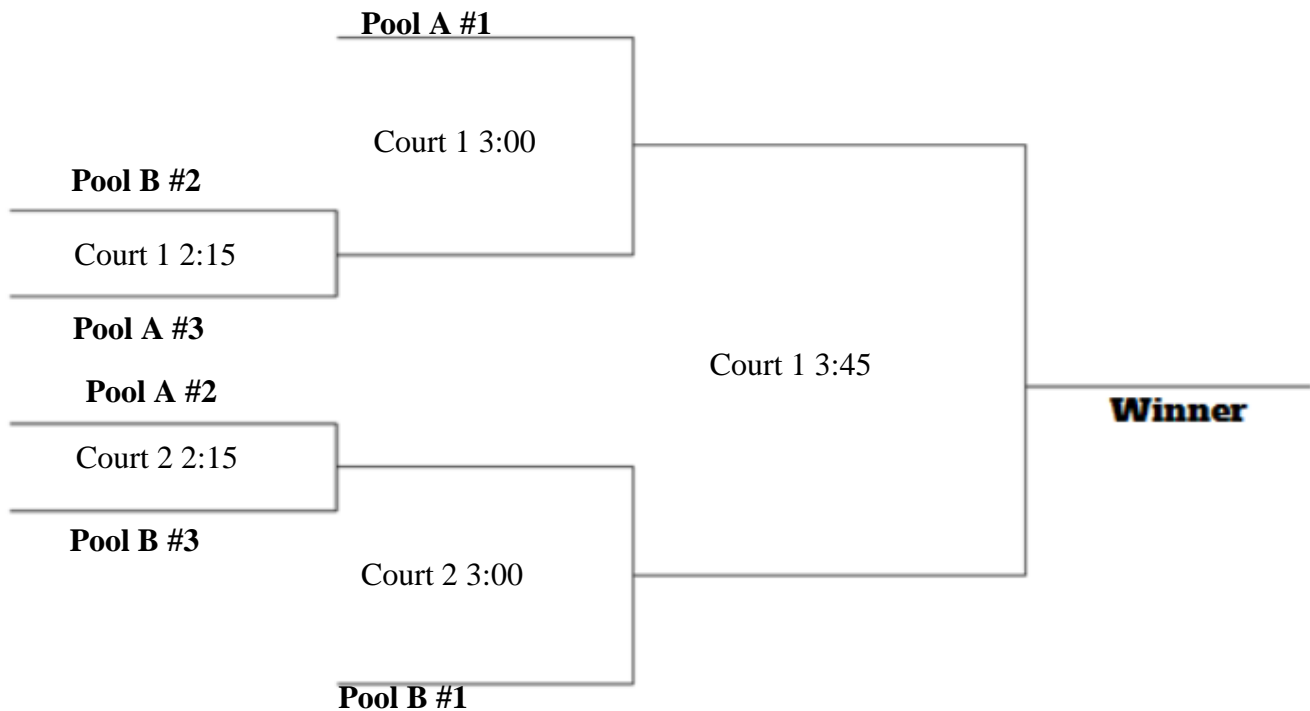
